Are you aware the Borough has ordinances and permits?

Are you thinking of adding a shed, fence or addition? What are the regulations? Do I need a building permit? Answers to these questions and more for home improvements and zoning can be answered by Lebanon County Planning. They are located in the Lebanon County Municipal building or by calling 717-228-4444.

Permits for sidewalk repairs, street shade tree removal, soliciting, and street openings (water, gas, etc.) must be obtained at the Borough office before any work is begun.

Borough Authority promotes conservation of water

The Authority works very hard to keep costs down for your sewer service. They also appreciate your efforts to conserve water by installing water saver toilets, shower heads or by fixing leaks immediately. Below are some typical problems that can add up to high water and sewer bills. These are usually

easy fixes through your home improvement store supply that can help in your water consumption. The City of Lebanon Authority will be happy to send someone out to your home at no charge to assist you if you suspect you have a leak! Call the water billing department at 717-675-2181 to schedule an appointment.
