PROPER DISPOSAL OF UNUSED PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

Federal prescription drug disposal guidelines urge Americans to:

- Take unused, unneeded, or expired prescription drugs out of their original containers.
- Smash pills, take capsules apart, and mix prescription drugs with an undesirable substance, such as used coffee grounds or kitty litter and put in impermeable, water-tight containers, such as empty cans or sealable bags to further ensure that the drugs are not diverted or accidentally ingested by children or pets.
- Throw these containers in your normal household trash.
