Fall Leaf Clean-Up



Leaf clean-up has already started for 2023! Just a reminder that *leaves only* should be placed at the curb **before 7:00 am** the day of collection. Please do not place sticks, grass clippings or other debris in with the leaves. Dividing lines are Center Street for East and West and Penn Avenue for North and South. Schedule is below:

Southwest	Tuesdays	Northeast	Thursdays
Southeast	Wednesdays	Northwest	Fridays

Please move your vehicles off the street on your scheduled day before 7:00am.

Please check your trees! If your tree limbs are less than 15' above the street or are in the curb way, your leaves will **NOT** be picked up so damage does not happen to the leaf truck. Please trim all bushes that hinder sidewalks as well.

Ordinance #503 states that only motorized vehicles are to be parked on Borough streets! Please remove **ALL** non-motorized vehicles from the street. This helps with leaf pick-up, street sweeping and snow removal.

Trick-or-Treat Night is scheduled for Tuesday, October 31, 2023, from 6:00 to 8:00pm. Rain date is scheduled for Wednesday November 1st.



Yard Sales

When advertising your yard sale, please do **NOT** place signs on the telephone poles with staples, nails or tacks. The line workers can be injured if their climbing hooks strike a nail, tack or staple. Please use tape or string to post your sale and remove all signs immediately after your sale to keep Cleona looking clean and neat.

Park and Recreation

The Park and Recreation Board are working vigorously on the **Fall Festival** set for October 21st from 2:00-7:00 for games & concessions with the Quittie Haunted Walk running from 7:00 to 9:00pm. This is the park's biggest fundraiser so please plan to attend to support your park. Our jack-o-lantern and costume contest is back as well as a magic show this year! Police Department

If you have a concern for the Police Department that is not an emergency, Chief Farneski asks that you do not wait to report the issue. Please contact the department immediately so your concern can be addressed appropriately. When leaving a voice mail message, please use the general mailbox and not a specific police officer's mailbox (unless that officer is already handling the issue for you).

Annville/Cleona Fire District

Ordinance #319 was passed June 4, 2018, regarding alarms. If your home has any type of alarm system (burglar, fire, etc), it must be registered with the Borough. Please contact the office to fill out a registration form.

Smoke Detectors: Please don't forget to **change the batteries** in your smoke detectors when you **turn your clocks back** on Sunday, November 5, 2023.

Open Burning



The Borough allows recreational burning, so residents can enjoy a crackling fire while entertaining in the backyard. Outdoor fireplaces made of clay, terra cotta or metal fueled only by wood (unpainted), charcoal briquettes or natural gas are approved but **must be screened** to prevent flying embers and hot ash. **It must never be left unattended or used to burn trash.** Also, please be mindful of your neighbors when enjoying your fire so the smoke does not interfere with **their** enjoyment of **their** outdoor space. (**Ordinance #175**)

Street Sweeping

Weather permitting, our last street sweeping for 2023 is scheduled for December 11th to the 14th. ***In order for this to be effective, we need your help!*** Please mark your phone/calendar for the day the street sweeper will be on your street and ***have your cars moved off the street by 7:00am***

North/South	Direction	Date
South Side	Streets running North & South	December 11
South Side	Streets running East & West	December 12
North Side	Streets running North & South	December 13
North Side	Streets running East & West	December 14

It is unlawful to let your pet run at large. All dogs must be licensed and leashed at all times. The Borough and Police Department do not have facilities to hold any animal. If you take control of an unleashed animal, please take the animal to the Humane Society.

Feral Cats: **YOU** can help control our feral cat problem by not feeding them!! The Borough has cat traps available to loan to residents. Kittens may have a chance of being domesticated. They may be taken to the Humane Society for adoption.
