STORMWATER CONSORTIUM

On March 22nd, Steckbeck Engineering & Surveying, Inc. (SESI) flew a drone above the Quittie between Dairy Road and Mill Street on behalf of the Lebanon Co. Stormwater Consortium. The purpose of the drone flight was to collect preliminary survey and topographic data which will be used to determine if this section of the creek is an ideal candidate for future floodplain restoration.

STREET SWEEPING

Cleona’s street sweeping schedule for April through July 2023 is below. For this program to be effective, **please have your car off the street by 7:00am the day of your scheduled street sweeping.** Please set your phone/tablet with a reminder to move your vehicle off the street on your scheduled day. The Borough is also working by inspecting storm drains and monitoring the streets, picking up debris to keep our streams and streets looking beautiful. You can keep **YOUR** Borough looking beautiful by keeping your curb line clear of debris and weeds and **NEVER** blowing your grass in the street. (Ordinance #271).

As a reminder our street sweeping schedule starts the second Monday of each month.

RECREATIONAL BURNING



The Borough allows recreational burning in outdoor fireplaces or chimineas **BUT MUST BE SCREENED** to prevent flying embers & hot ash. **It must never be left unattended or used to burn trash.** *Please be mindful of your neighbors when enjoying the fire so it does not interfere with their enjoyment of their outdoor space.

HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority sponsors a household hazardous waste collection (lawn, garden chemicals, paint, stains, varnishes, automotive batteries, cleaners, fluorescent tubes). Lebanon County residents may schedule an at home collection by calling 1-800-742-5542 ext 123 or www.mxiinc.com/lebanon. A \$15.00 co-payment is required to schedule a pick-up and is limited to one pick-up per household per year. MUNICIPAL TRASH

PARKING

The office and police department have received concerns about parking on the streets. Ordinance #261 states **only** motorized vehicles are to be parked on Borough streets. Please remove all non-motorized items immediately. Permits for dumpsters to be placed for a short period of time may be obtained in the Borough office.
