WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO DISPLAY A HOUSE NUMBER!



- So ambulances, fire trucks and the police can find you efficiently.
- It is a violation of the International Property Maintenance Code that could result in a fine.
- Numbers should be at least 4" high and contrast with their background.

IT'S GRASS GROWING SEASON!

- Keep grass at a *maximum* height of 6"
- Keep trees trimmed to 15' above the street and 9' above a sidewalk
- Bushes/trees should be cut back from your neighbor's property and off any sidewalk.

MOSQUITO PREVENTION AT HOME

Protect yourself from mosquito bites by following The Three Ds:

- **DRAIN:** Eliminate all standing water on your property that could be breeding mosquitoes. Use a commercially available Bti larvicide for water that cannot be drained.
- **DRESS:** Wear loose-fitting, long clothing that covers the skin when spending time outdoors and treat clothing with permethrin.
- **DEFEND:** Use EPA-registered insect repellents

FACELIFT FOR THE BUTTERFLY GARDEN AT THE CLEONA PARK

The butterfly garden, located down by the creek, is getting a complete makeover. As his Eagle Scout project, Jahronme Gonzalez-Allie from Troop 440, will be ripping out all of the old vegetation and replacing it with 15 Native Perennials for a Sunny Pollinator Garden.

Ashlea Good, Cleona's own horticultural expert, has assisted Jahronme with a list of suitable replacement plants. They include plants for Spring, Summer, & Fall. They're also adding one grass because they are important for birds as a food source and an ideal place for caterpillars to over-winter.
