Keep the Borough Beautiful!

- All rubbish (litter, refuse, items not put in your regular trash) must be removed from your property. Having rubbish harbors rodents and other critters!
- Electronics may be recycled for free at Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority and landfill licenses are only \$15.00/year for residents. All information may be obtained at gogra.org.
- All exposed/cracked/peeling wood should be repainted.
- Unregistered and uninspected vehicles (abandoned vehicles) must be brought to legal street operation, stored in an enclosed structure, or removed from the street and your property.
- All trash must be in receptacles that are watertight, have a tight cover, and are in good condition. Ordinance #261
- Motor oil, and tires may be recycled at the following: Henise Tire, Auto Zone, and Advance Auto. Leaking oil pans and containers are a MS4 violation and would be reported to the DEP as illicit discharge.
- Mulch and blowing grass in the street is an MS4 violation!!

Please stop by the park to see the newly installed Basics Trail provided by Lebanon Valley College, United Way, and the Lebanon County Health Council. The walk is geared for interaction between a parent and small children. It is the first of its kind in Pennsylvania!

RECREATIONAL BURNING

The Borough allows recreational burning in outdoor fireplaces or chimineas with wood or charcoal briquettes.

It must be screened and never left unattended! Please be mindful of the smoke so it does not disturb your neighbors so they can enjoy their outdoor space.

IT'S GROWING SEASON!

- Keep grass at a *maximum* height of 6”
- Keep trees trimmed to 15’ above the street and 9’ above a sidewalk
- Bushes/trees should be cut back from your neighbor’s property and off any sidewalk.
- It is your responsibility to clean all the way to the curb!

STREET SWEEPING

Cleona’s street sweeping schedule for July & Aug 2023 is below. For this program to be effective, *please have your car off the street by 7:00am the day of your scheduled street sweeping.* Please set your phone/tablet with a reminder to move your vehicle off the street on your scheduled day. The Borough is inspecting storm drains, monitoring the streets, and picking up debris to keep our streams and streets looking beautiful. You can keep **YOUR** Borough looking beautiful by keeping your curb line clear of debris and weeds and NEVER blowing your grass in the street. (Ordinance #271).

As a reminder our street sweeping schedule starts the second Monday of each month.

North/South	Direction	3rd Sweeping	4th Sweeping
South Side	Streets running North & South	July 10	August 14
South Side	Streets running East & West	July 11	August 15
North Side	Streets running North & South	July 12	August 16
North Side	Streets running East & West	July 13	August 17

GREEN WASTE DISPOSAL

The Borough has arrangements with North Cornwall for disposal of green waste. Residents who wish to participate need to come into the Borough office to obtain a residency verification form before proceeding to North Cornwall Township. An annual permit costs \$30.00. A \$5.00 deposit is required for first issuance of a key card (refundable at the end of the calendar year with return of the card) or you may use the “Pay-As-You-Go” method of \$4.00 per bag or container at each arrival. North Cornwall Township is located at 320 South 18th Street.

BOROUGH OFFICE NEWS

Office hours are Monday through Friday from 9:00-5:00pm. We will be closed September 4th for Labor Day. Permits for sidewalks, curbs & driveways may be obtained at the office.
