CLEARING SIDEWALKS: Residents are responsible for clearing their sidewalks of snow/ice within 24 hours of the snowfall or ice storm. (Ordinance #223).



MATERIAL IN THE STREET: When removing snow/ice, NEVER throw/snow blow material into the street. Ordinance #271 prohibits anyone to throw/dump *anything* in the streets, culverts, catch basins, or within 20 feet of a fire hydrant.



SNOW REMOVAL: The borough contracts for snow removal. Please allow them to do their jobs by getting your cars off the street so that roads and alleyways are clear for driving.



ADOPT A FIRE HYDRANT: To assist the Annville/Cleona Fire Company, residents that have a fire hydrant on or near their property are asked to remove all snow around the hydrant. This will assist the Fire Company with being able to respond quicker in case of an emergency.

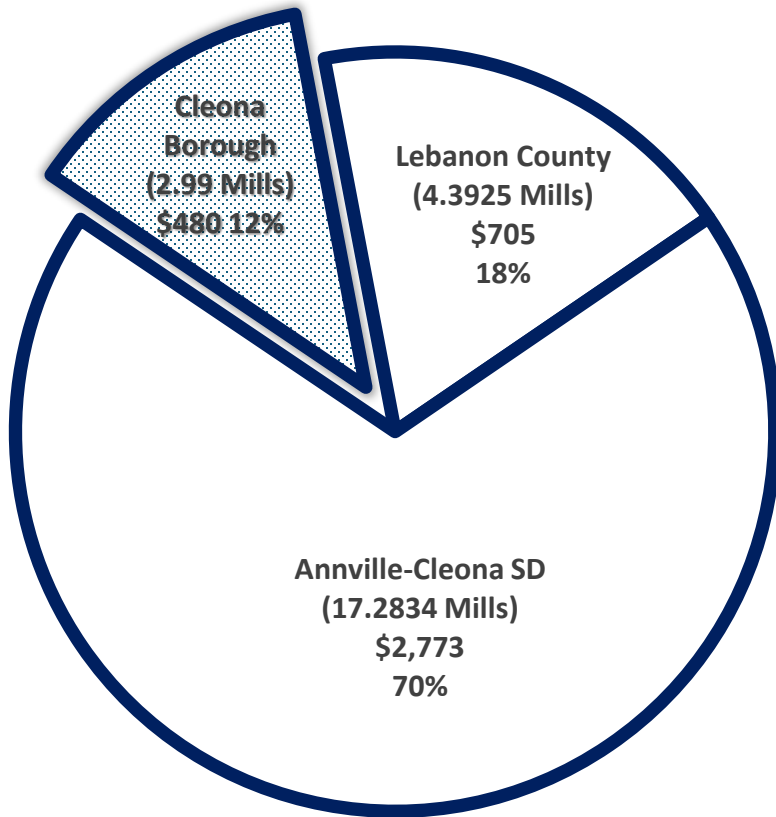
Cleona Borough According to the Census Bureau, in 2023:

Tips for What to Do When You Encounter Aggressive Drivers

If you encounter an aggressive driver, PennDOT offers these tips for what to do:

- Get out of their way and don't challenge them.
- Stay relaxed, avoid eye contact and ignore rude gestures.
- Don't block the passing lane if you are driving slower than most of the traffic.
- Do not attempt to follow or pursue the vehicle. You or a passenger may call the police. But, if you use a cell phone, pull over to a safe location.
