Sewer bill unusually high?

Check your consumption! Is your toilet running? Add food dye to the tank and wait an hour. If the dye is in the bowl, your toilet is leaking! Even a small leak can make your sewer bill extremely high!

It's Snowing! What Should I Do?

CLEARING SIDEWALKS:

Residents are responsible for clearing their sidewalks of snow/ice within 24 hours of the snowfall or ice storm. (Ordinance #223)



MATERIAL IN THE STREET:

When removing snow/ice, NEVER throw/blow snow material into the street. Ordinance #271 prohibits anyone to throw/dump *anything* in the streets, culverts, catch basins, or within 20 feet of a fire hydrant



SNOW REMOVAL:

The borough contracts for snow removal. Please allow them to do their jobs by getting your cars off the street so that roads and alleyways are clear for driving.

Free Christmas Tree Recycling

Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority (GLRA) has a free Christmas tree recycling program. Trees under 10 feet and with no decorations or paint are accepted from December 26 to February 21 during regular hours. No permit is required.



Plan to Fix Borough Roads

It is no secret that some Cleona roads are in poor shape. To fix this long-standing problem, Borough Council decided to repave a street about every three years. Streets will be repaved based on a prioritized list developed by the Borough engineer. To pay for this plan, Council voted to increase property taxes 0.40 mills. Funds from this tax will be put into a Capital Fund account and used exclusively for street paving. The average property owner will pay an extra \$128 per year, or about \$11 per month.
